

The definition of harassment, bullying, and intimidation, as defined by the Ohio Revised Code is “intentional written, verbal, graphic, physical or electronic act that a student or group of students exhibited toward the alleged victim more than once; and the behavior both causes mental or physical harm to the other student, and is sufficiently severe, persistent or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening or abusive educational environment for the other student.” The Ohio Revised Code also establishes that “the board of education of each city, local, exempted village, and joint vocational school district shall establish a policy prohibiting harassment, intimidation, or bullying.” (ORC3313.666).
