- ✓ Youngstown Community School has the same percentage of economically disadvantaged students as local schools;
- ✓ Youngstown Community School also serves less students with special needs than Youngstown City, the school of origin for most enrolled students;
- ✓ English Learner students are not enrolling in Youngstown Community School, ensuring marketing is in other languages.
- ✓ Black, non-Hispanic students are represented at a much higher percentage at Youngstown Community School. Than all schools that serve in this area.
- ✓ School in similar percentages, compared to like schools, but significantly less than Youngstown City;
- ✓ Hispanic/Latino populations are represented, however, Youngstown Community School will incorporate multi-language flyers and correspondence and will review files of withdrawn students to develop a plan to reach these students. This population is underrepresented based on percentage at other schools nearby.
