Feb. 1 - April 1: Submit Letter of Intent – public students

Feb. 1 - April 1 at 5:00 pm: Sign-up for a OH|ID Account – nonpublic and homeschool parents

Feb. 1 - April 1 at 5:00 pm: Apply for funding – nonpublic and homeschool parents

Before May 6: Funding award notifications sent – nonpublic and homeschool parents

College Credit Plus for Students and Families

Ohio's College Credit Plus can help you earn college and high school credits at the same time by taking college courses from community colleges or universities. The purpose of this program is to promote rigorous academic pursuits and to provide a wide variety of options to college-ready students. Taking a college course from a public college or university College Credit Plus is **free** for students. That means no cost for tuition, books or fees if you attend public school in the state of Ohio. If you choose to attend a private college or are homeschooled, you may have limited costs.
