Early Intervention Wellness Coordinator to coordinate school based and community based services to address learning barriers. This person will conduct parent meetings, make home visits, work with staff to decrease barriers based on the Early Warning System.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Reading Intervention/Science of Reading Supplement</p> <p>Each grade band will have a lead teacher to lead teacher based team meetings and report to the Building leadership team.</p>

3. Mental Health Services:

- a. School Based Counselor:
Provide school-based mental health services to a diverse student population. Service goals include, but are not limited to, providing prevention, early intervention, and treatment services to students individually or in groups. Position provides crisis intervention services, including assessment, coordination, and follow up. Clinicians will provide continuity of care throughout the school year.
- b. Insight Counseling: New Free partnership with YCS; offer therapeutic services and behavior supports.
